A computer controlled touch screen interface operates 18 shower heads, divided into 6 zones, and programmed with therapeutically designed sequences and custom sequences tailored to the user. Each zone is capable of varying in temperature, pressure, and time with **speed and precision** that would be impossible to duplicate by hand.

The SilverTAG shower provides an escape to the pressures and stresses of our ever increasing daily demands. The specialty shoulder showerhead designed by TAG targets the neck and shoulders to relieve tension. With the possible shower sequences including Think, Tonic, Spa, Rain, Anti-Stress, and Never-Ending, you can optimize your water treatment daily with the simple touch of a button.

The shower will be customized for you or your family or it can be designed to accommodate a variety of people in a club or commercial application. Our TAG team of experts will guide you through the entire construction. We will walk you through the design process and work with your builder, including site visits, to insure the shower is built and operates according to the design.

The SilverTAG Shower

1) **About Us**

TAG Galyean has been the leader in the creative development of American luxury spa hydrotherapies since 1986. He has developed unique spas for such world famous destinations such as The Greenbrier, The Broadmoor, The Lodge at Pebble Beach, Turnberry Isle Resort and The Hotel Hershey. You can now bring The SilverTAG Shower into your home or club and personalize your surroundings with the glamour of a luxury resort and the therapies of world class spas.

2) **Description of the Shower**

The SilverTAG shower is computer controlled to quickly and accurately change the water temperature and pressure from its eighteen showerheads. From the touch screen, one can chose from several sequences designed by spa specialists for relaxation, invigoration, and to increase circulation. Custom sequences can be created and saved for daily use.

The standard shower is designed with six zones: Overhead, Shoulders, Upper Torso, Lower Torso, Upper Legs, and Lower Legs. Each zone has independent controls for temperature and pressure. Fixtures have been carefully selected for each zone to have the most beneficial effects. TAG Signature has designed and manufactured the shoulder showerhead specifically for this application.

3) **Examples of Shower Sequences**

a) **Relax: Soothing, hydro experience designed to address symptoms of stress**

Enjoy a gentle pressure of warm water that gradually builds, moving up and down your entire body "washing" your cares away. This full body water massage provides deep relaxation to naturally counter the effects of daily stress.

b) **Relief: Target muscle tension with healing water**

Hot water and focused pressure unite to penetrate relief deeply into muscle tissue alleviating tension and stiffness. The neck, shoulders, and back, famous for holding the greatest muscle tension, are specifically targeted.

c) **Tonic: Invigorating traditional hydrotherapy**

With water fully enveloping you from all the showerheads, the temperature rises gradually from warm to hot. Suddenly, the hot water plunges to refreshing cool temperatures. As the waters become warm again you will experience a traditional spa sequence of simultaneous hot and cold water, providing the ultimate invigorating hydrotherapy.

d) **Shape: Anti cellulite hydrotherapy**

Combat cellulite with a hydrotherapy massage and thermal stimulation. Targeted hydrotherapy sequences aimed at the thighs, buttocks, and stomach, are designed to increase circulation and enhance cellulite reduction as part of a complete anti cellulite program.

e) **Custom Sequences: Developed on an individual basis**

If a specific sequence is desired, TAG Signature will work with you to develop a sequence or sequences of your liking or needs. We will also include a custom daily wash and shampoo sequence

4) Description of Items and Services Provided by TAG Signature Inc.

a) Drawings and Directions

Detailed drawings and diagrams will be provided to communicate the shower layout, piping and plumbing requirements, and electrical and communication needs. Directions will be provided by TAG Signature for the installation of all the equipment.

b) Professional Services and Visits:

i) Initial Visit

A TAG Signature designer will visit the client and site for the shower. During this visit the details and information for customizing the shower will be gathered. In addition the location for the shower will be studied to insure a smooth installation.

ii) Coordination with Builder and/or Contractor

A TAG Signature designer will be communicating with the builder and/ or contractor during any needed construction to be sure that the needed specifications for the shower are understood and are being met. This coordination will be facilitated by phone calls, digital images and video as needed.

iii) Installation

With the finishes of the shower complete a TAG Signature designer and engineer will visit the site to install the software, check operations, and train the client in the use of the shower.

iv) Follow Up and Fine Tuning

After 9 months, a TAG Signature designer will make a follow up visit to make any needed adjustments and fine-tune the shower upon the client's request.

c) Items Provided:

TAG Signature Inc will provide 18 showerheads, the temperature and flow control valves, the touch screen, the computer controls as well as additional electronics required to monitor and control the function of the shower.

5) Requirements Responsibility of Client

a) Specifications and Requirements

The following Specifications for the SilverTAG Shower are guidelines. As the SilverTAG Shower is custom designed for each client, TAG Signature will work with the client to determine the exact requirements for your specific needs.

i) Water Requirements

Water supply is to be the following or equivalent:

1 1/2" pipe of 60-degree water at 80 psi and a 1 1/2" pipe of 130-degree water at 80 psi.

There is to be 130-degree hot water supply of 230 gallons for each 5-minute shower sequence.

The drain is to be able to quickly remove water at the volume of 65-gpm.

ii) Electrical Requirements

There is to be a 15 amp electrical circuit isolated for each shower system.

There is to be a high speed Internet connection in the mechanical closet for remote computer maintenance for each shower. It is highly recommended that the client has a computer with internet access.

iii) Spatial Requirements

The shower area is to be a minimum of 4' by 4' by 8' 6" (height).

The touch screen control is to be mounted in the shower area. Wiring is required between the touch screen and the mechanical closet.

A mechanical closet of 3' 6" (height) by 5' 6" (width) by 12" (depth) is required for the control valves and electronics. Structural backing is to be provided in the closet for mounting of the valves and electronics. The location of the mechanical closet needs to be adjacent to the shower area and requires full access for maintenance. Other proportions for the mechanical closet can be considered in the event that the above dimensions are not possible.

The floor is to be detailed to be water tight and sloped to remove water at a rate of 65-gpm.

The entire shower enclosure is to be extensively waterproofed with a water barrier or membrane on floor and the full height of the walls.

b) Items Required of Client

Plumbing, mounting and installation of the valves (which are provided by TAG Signature), electrical wiring, and finishes are the responsibility of the client.

c) Liability Waiver

For work to commence, a liability waiver must be signed by the client

6) Adjustments and Warranty

a) Adjustments

Adjustments to the shower sequences (i.e. temperature adjustments) are covered for 2 weeks following the beginning of use date. After that time, the client can use the password protected website to make changes to their sequences that are then downloaded into the touch screen. If the client prefers to have TAG Signature make these adjustments, we will bill the client at a rate of \$125/hr. At nine months, we will provide a follow up to make adjustments or fine tune the shower.

b) Warranty

The warranty on all parts varies according to the manufacturer. The valves have a 5 year warranty from the date of purchase. The touch screen is warranted for 1 year. **Our software is warranted for 9 months with 90 days of phone or email support. For support that can not be remedied via phone or email, we expect the client to pay for travel. After 90 days, support will be billed at \$125/hr. Although we do not anticipate problems, any that occur usually do so in the first day or two.**

7) **Cost and Payment**

a) Cost

The cost is \$100,000 each. This includes the design and development as well as the services and items listed in Section 2 above. We do offer a discount for the purchase of multiple units.

b) Payment

A non-refundable deposit of \$10,000 is needed for TAG Signature to arrange the initial visit by a designer. A 50% deposit is required for work to begin. Both of these deposits will be applied to the final invoice.

c) Delay in Installation and/or Construction

If at any point the installation and/ or construction is delayed for four weeks or longer, TAG Signature will put the shower project on indefinite hold. At this point it will cost an additional \$10,000 to reinstate the project as active.
